## Advanced Lego-Animation

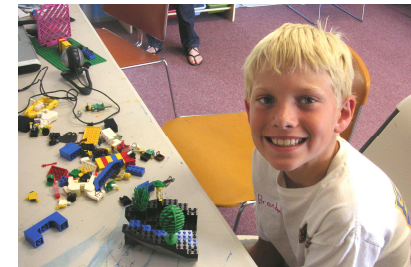
**Saturdays, February 18 – March 17:**

**Recommended for children in grades 4 and above.**

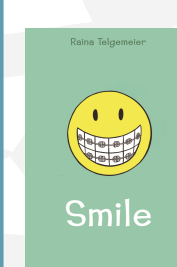

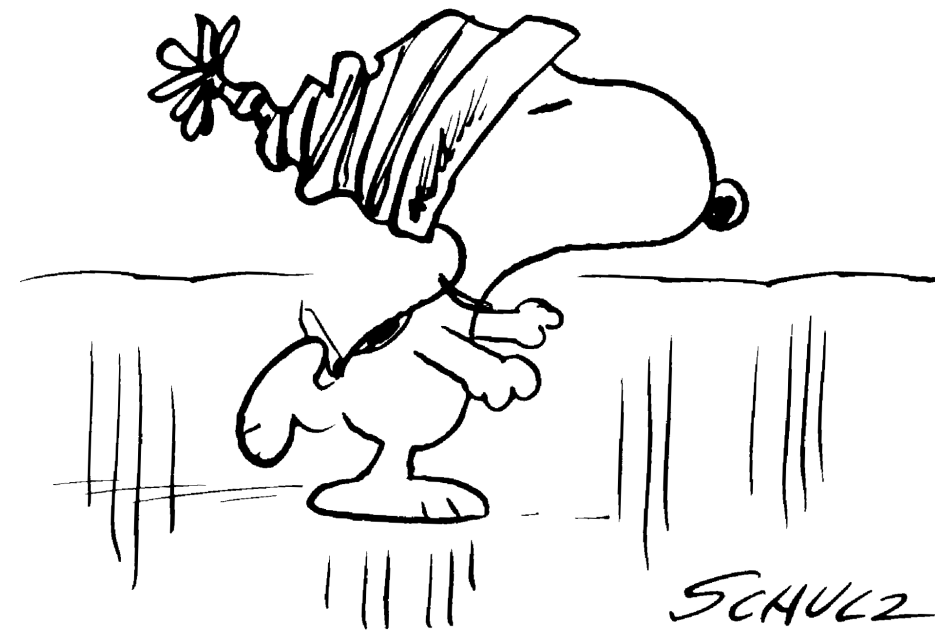
